BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

Amendment
of section 67
of the
principal
Law.

1. This Law may be cited as the Criminal Code (Amendment) Law, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Criminal Code (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. Section 67 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion in the definition of "Riot", contained in the third paragraph thereof, immediately after the words "the purpose" (line 1), of the commas and words ", whether of a public or of a private nature,".
