A LAW TO AMEND THE INTERPRETATION LAW.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Interpretation (Amendment) Law, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Interpretation Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. Section 20 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:—

"Powers of
Governor
where public
officer is
unable to

20. Where the Governor is satisfied that the holder of any public office is unable for any cause to perform the functions of that office, it shall be lawful for the Governor either to appoint another person to that office or to direct that the said functions shall be performed by a person named by him or by the person for the time being holding, or lawfully performing the functions of, some other public office ; and all the functions of the first mentioned office shall accordingly vest (subject to any conditions, exceptions or qualifications which the Governor may prescribe) in such person until his appointment or the direction, as the case may be, is terminated by the Governor."
