A LAW TO AMEND THE HOTELS LAW.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Hotels (Amendment) Law, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Hotels Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. Section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the substitution for the definition of "hotel" of the following :—
" 'hotel' means any building or premises, howsoever described, used for the accommodation of the public in which lodgings are provided and provisions are supplied by the keeper or manager thereof ".

3. Section 5 of the principal Law is hereby amended by renumbering the same 5 (1) and adding at the end thereof the following new sub-section :—

" (2) No hotel shall be licensed under a name which, in the opinion of the Hotels Board, is undesirable, unsuitable or misleading ".
