A LAW TO AMEND THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW. CAP. 165

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Streets and Buildings Regulation (Amendment) Law, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. Sub-section (2) of section 14 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the substitution of a colon for the full stop at the end thereof and the addition of the following proviso :—

"Provided that if the appropriate authority declares itself to be satisfied that the public interest requires the issue of a permit, the Governor, after receiving and considering such declaration, may, in his absolute discretion, authorise the appropriate authority to issue a permit otherwise than in accordance with such notice."
