A LAW TO AMEND THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE LAW.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Law, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Criminal Procedure Law (hereinafter referred to as the " principal Law ").

2. Section 8 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section, to be numbered " 8 " :—

8. Without prejudice to the generality of section 3 of this Law and without prejudice to the operation of section 5 of this Law the rules for the time being approved by Her Majesty's Judges of the Queen's Bench Division in England relating to the taking of statements by police officers (known as " The Judges' Rules ") shall apply to the taking of statements in the Colony as they apply to the taking of statements in England."
