Η Βουλή των Αντιπροσώπων ψηφίζει τα ακόλουθα:

1. Ο παρών Νόμος θα αναφέρεται ως ο περι της Διεθνούς Συμβατεως περί Ασφάλειας της Ανθρώπινης Ζωής στη Θάλασσα του 1974 (Κυρωτικός Τροποποιήσεων) Νόμος του 1989 και θα εφαρμόζεται σε συνδυασμό με τον περί της Διεθνούς Συμβάσεως περί Ασφάλειας της Ανθρώπινης Ζωής στη Θάλασσα του 1974, του Πρωτόκολλου αυτής του 1978 και των Αποφάτεων MSC1(XLV) και MSC2(XLV) του 1981 (Κυρωτικού Νόμου του 1985 στο εξής αναφερομένου ως «ο βασικός νόμος») και ο παρών Νόμος και ο βασικός νόμος θα αναφέρονται μαζί ως οι περί της Διεθνούς Συμβάσεως τερί Ασφάλειας της Ανθρώπινης Ζωής στη Θάλασσα (Κυρωτικοί) Νόμοι του 1985 και 1989.

«Σύμβαση» σημαίνει τη Σύμβαση η οποία εκτίθεται στον Πίνακα του βασικού νόμου

«Τροποποιήσεις» σημαίνει τις τρεις τροποποιήσεις της Συμβάσεας οι οποίες υιοθετήθηκαν στις 17 Ιουνίου 1983 από την Επιτροπή Ναυτκής Ασφάλειας του Διεθνούς Ναυτιλιακού Οργανισμού με βάση τρεις εποφάσεις της Επιτροπής αυτής με αρ. MSC4 (48), MSC5 (48) και MSC6 (48), των οποίων το κείμενο, μαζί με την προτασσόμενη οικεία Απόωιση, εκτίθεται στο αγγλικό πρωτότυπο στο Μέρος Ι του Πίνακα κα σε ελληνική μετάφραση στο Μέρος ΙΙ του Πίνακα:

Νοείται ότι σε περίπτωση αντιθέσεως μεταξύ των δύο αυτών κειμένων θα υπερισχύει το κείμενο του αγγλικού πρωτότυπου.

- 3. Με τον παρόντα Νόμο κυρώνονται οι Τροποποιήσεις, των οποιών η αποδοχή αποφασίσθηκε με την υπ' αρ. 31.026 και ημερομηνία 8.11.38 Απόφαση του Υπουργικού Συμβουλίου.
- **4.** Το άρθρο 6 του βασικού νόμου τροποποιείται με την προσθήκη ττο τέλος αυτού της ακόλουθης επιφυλάξεως:

«Νοείται ότι προκειμένου περί εκτάκτων και ειδικών περιπτώσεων, η πιο πάνω αναφερόμενη απόφαση του Υπουργού δεν επιβάλλετα, να δημοσιευθεί στην επίσημη εφημερίδα της Δημοκρατίας.».

RESOLUTION MSC.6(48) adopted on 17 June 1983

ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION FOR THE SAFETY OF LIFE AT SEA, 1974

THE MARITIME SAFETY COMMITTEE,

NOTING article VIII(b) of the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, 1974, hereafter referred to as "the Convention", concerning the procedure for amending the Annex to the Convention, other than the provisions of chapter I thereof,

NOTING FURTHER the functions which the Convention confers upon the Maritime Safety Committee for the consideration and adoption of amendments to the Convention,

HAVING CONSIDERED at its forty-eighth session amendments to the Convention proposed and circulated in accordance with article VIII(b)(i) thereof,

- 1 ADOPTS in accordance with article VIII(b)(iv) of the Convention amendments to chapters II-1, II-2, III, IV and VII of the Convention, the texts of which are given in the Annex to the present resolution;
- DETERMINES in accordance with article VIII(b)(vi)(2)(bb) of the Convention that the amendments to chapters II-1, II-2, III, IV and VII shall be deemed to have been accepted on I January 1986 unless prior to this date more than one third of Contracting Governments to the Convention or Contracting Governments the combined merchant fleets of which constitute not less than 50% of the gross tonnage of the world's merchant fleet, have notified their objections to the amendments:
- 3 INVITES Contracting Governments to note that in accordance with article VIII(b)(vii)(2) of the Convention the amendments to chapters II-1, II-2, III, IV and VII shall enter into force on 1 July 1986 upon their acceptance in accordance with paragraph 2 above;
- 4 REQUESTS the Secretary-General in conformity with article VIII(b)(v) of the Convention to transmit certified copies of the present resolution and the texts of the amendments contained in the Annex to all Contracting Governments to the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, 1974;
- 5 FURTHER REQUESTS the Secretary-General to transmit copies of the resolution and its Annex to Members of the Organization which are not Contracting Governments to the Convention.
