No. 99. **THE LEPERS LAW.**
CAP. 112.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 13 of the Lepers Law, Cap. 112, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Leper Farm (Amendment) Regulations, 1953, and shall be read as one with the Leper Farm Regulations, 1932 and 1939 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Leper Farm Regulations, 1932 to 1953.

2. Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is hereby repealed and the following regulation substituted therefor :—

" Upon arrival of the leper the Director of Medical and Health Services shall cause the leper to be examined and on confirmation of the diagnosis made by the District Medical Officer as expressed in the certificate mentioned in regulation 3, shall make all necessary arrangements for the future treatment of such leper. Should the Director of Medical and Health Services consider it desirable that the leper undergoes treatment in the Leper Farm, he shall countersign such certificate and forward same to the Colonial Secretary with a request for the issue of an order by the Governor for such leper's detention in the Leper Farm ".
