

THE HORSE BREEDING LAW.

(CAP. 103.)

LICENSING OF STALLIONS REGULATIONS.

30 Gaz. 1145

1. These regulations may be cited as the Licensing of Stallions Regulations.
2. Every licence for a stallion shall be in the form set forth in the Appendix hereto. Appendix.
3. Any stallion in respect of which a licence is granted may be branded or marked by the Inspector in a manner whereby the same may be known and identified.
4. The Inspector shall keep a Register of Stallions in respect of which a licence is granted and such Register shall contain the following particulars :—
 - (a) The number of the licence.
 - (b) The name and address of the owner of the stallion.
 - (c) The colour, markings, age and height of the stallion.
 - (d) The date on which the licence is issued.
 - (e) The date on which the licence is suspended or revoked, if such be the case.
