No. 182. THE VILLAGE AUTHORITIES LAW.
CAP. 256 AND LAW 17 OF 1951.

PROCLAMATION UNDER SECTION 17.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the boundaries of the villages of Karakoumi and Kazaphani in the District of Kyrenia:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 17 of the Village Authorities Law and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, the Governor, do hereby proclaim that from and after the 15th day of May, 1953, the area described in the Schedule hereto, heretofore reckoned within the boundaries of the village of Kazaphani in the District of Kyrenia, shall form part of the lands of the village of Karakoumi, in the District of Kyrenia, and that the boundaries of the said villages of Kazaphani and Karakoumi shall be altered accordingly. SCHEDULE.

Area to be transferred from Kazaphani village to Karakoumi village:—

The boundary commences at the north-western corner of plot No. 432 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII.21, locality "Karakoumitika", which corner is on the Kyrenia-Ayios Amvrosios main road and proceeds south-eastwards along the said road to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 203/1/2 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII.22; thence south-westwards along the boundary of and including the said plot to its most southern point, which point is on a track, locality "Lyvas"; thence north-westwards along the said track to the most southern point of plot No. 430/2 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII.21, which point is on the right bank of the river Koutsoullina; thence north-westwards along the said bank to the point of commencement. All which said boundary is delineated in red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1581.
