THE MERCHANT SHIPPING (SAFETY REGULATION AND SEAMEN) LAWS, 1952 AND 1953.

PROCLAMATION UNDER SECTION 12 (2).

Whereas it is provided by sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Merchant Shipping (Safety Regulation and Seamen) Laws, 1952 and 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") that they shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the Governor by proclamation published in the *Gazette*, which day shall not be earlier than the day on which Her Majesty's approval of the Law shall have been signified by proclamation published in like manner;

And whereas Her Majesty has been pleased to approve the Law by the Merchant Shipping (Confirmation of Legislation) (Cyprus) Order, 1953, which came into operation on the twenty-third day of June, 1953;

And whereas Her Majesty's approval of the Law has been proclaimed in the Colony by publication of the aforesaid Order in the *Gazette*:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Law, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby proclaim that the thirteenth day of August, 1953, shall be the day on which the Law shall come into operation.
