THE LAND ACQUISITION (PAPHOS EARTHQUAKE) LAW, 1953.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (1) (c).

Whereas under section 3 (1) (c) of the Land Acquisition (Paphos Earthquake) Law, 1953, the Commissioner has power to acquire, by order, any land which, in his opinion, is required for the purposes generally of providing houses to persons rendered homeless by earthquake;

And whereas certain land is required for this purpose in consequence of the earthquake which occurred on the 10th September, 1953:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 (1) (c) of the Land Acquisition (Paphos Earthquake) Law, 1953, I, Ian Malcolm Gordon Williams, Commissioner of Paphos District, do hereby order that the area of land, particulars and description of which are given on the Schedule hereto, be acquired for the above purpose.
