In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2 (1) of the Pensions Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Pensionable Offices (Declaration and Consolidation) (Amendment) Order, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Pensionable Offices (Declaration and Consolidation) Order, 1953, and the Pensionable Offices (Declaration and Consolidation) (Amendment) Order, 1953 (hereinafter together referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Pensionable Offices (Declaration and Consolidation) Orders, 1953 to 1954.

2. In addition to the offices declared to be pensionable offices under the principal Order, the offices set out in the Schedule hereto are declared pensionable offices for the purposes of the above Law.
