THE SHEEP AND GOATS (SHEPHERDS' LICENSING AND CONTROL) LAW.

CAP. 157.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Sheep and Goats (Shepherds' Licensing and Control) Law, I hereby direct that during the period between the 10th June, 1954 and the 9th August, 1954, flocks, within the area of Kato Zodia, Nicosia District, shall, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, be kept inside an enclosure and not taken outside an enclosure :

Provided that nothing in this notice contained shall prevent the driving of any flock, under the proper charge of a licensed shepherd, from one village area to another, along any public road, at any hour.

THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.

CAP. 142.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Phini, in the District of Limassol, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF PHINI UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, Cap. 142, the Village Health Commission of Phini hereby make the following rules :—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Phini) (Amendment) Rules, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Phini) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Phini) Rules, 1938 and 1954.

2. Rule 46 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and the following rule substituted therefor :—

"Rule 46.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say :—

| (a) For every carcass of any animal or part thereof not exceeding 20 okes | 1 | 0 |
| (b) For every carcass of any animal or part thereof exceeding 20 okes but not exceeding 50 okes | 2 | 0 |
| (c) For every carcass of any animal or part thereof exceeding 50 okes | 3 | 0 |

(2) The fees in paragraph (1) of this rule prescribed shall not be payable by any person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, who is a monthly or yearly lessee of any shop, stall or place in the meat market under rule 45 of these Rules."
