CAP. 142.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Akhna, in the District of Famagusta, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF AKHNA UNDER
SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Akhna hereby make the following rules :—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Akhna) (Amendment) Rules, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Akhna) Rules, 1938 and 1948 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules") and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Akhna) Rules, 1938 to 1954. 2. The following rules shall be substituted for Rules 20, 46 and 57, respectively, of the principal Rules :—

"Rule 20.—The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in a slaughter-house, that is to say :—

(a) for every bullock, camel, cow or ox	2	0
(b) for every goat, sheep, kid or lamb of 9 okes or under carcass weight	6	
(c) for every goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 9 okes carcass weight	1	0
(d) for every he-goat or ram over one year of age	1	0
(e) for every swine	2	0

Rule 46.—The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say :—

(a) for every carcass of bullock, camel, cow or ox	2	0
(b) for every carcass of goat, sheep, kid or lamb of 9 okes or under carcass weight	3	
(c) for every carcass of goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 9 okes carcass weight	6	
(d) for every carcass of he-goat or ram over one year of age	1	0
(e) for every carcass of swine of 40 okes or under carcass weight	1	0
(f) for every carcass of swine above 40 okes or under 80 okes carcass weight	2	0
(g) for every carcass of swine above 80 okes carcass weight	3	0

Rule 57.—The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by any person exposing for sale any animal in the animal market, that is to say :—

(a) for every lamb or kid under 6 months	6	
(b) for every lamb or kid over 6 months and for every ewe, goat, ram and he-goat	1	0
(c) for every swine under 6 months	1	0
(d) for every swine over 6 months	1	6
(e) for every bullock, cow, ox, heifer, camel, mule or horse	2	0
(f) for every ass	1	0
