THE TOBACCO LAW.

CAP. 170 AND LAWS 41 OF 1953 AND 33 OF 1954.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 42 (2).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by sub-section (2) of section 42 of the Tobacco Law, I hereby prescribe that the form of banderoles to be affixed to packets of tobacco manufactured in, and for delivery for consumption in, the Colony shall conform with the specimens, descriptions, length and width thereof appearing hereunder :—

Cap. 170
41 of 1953
33 of 1954

4 drams :—(Specimen banderole of 4 drams).

Description :—Black and red lettering on a white ground.

8 drams :—(Specimen banderole of 8 drams).

Description :—Green and red lettering on a white ground.

Width :—not exceeding $\frac{5}{8}$ of an inch.

Length :—not exceeding $5\frac{3}{8}$ inches.

APPOINTMENT OF COMMITTEES OF MANAGEMENT FOR THE MARONITE SCHOOLS UNDER SECTION 23.
