**NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.**

Whereas by Notification No. 61 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 3rd February, 1955, the Grain Commission (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") established under section 4 of the Grain Control Law, 1953, has been recognised as a public body for the purposes of the Land Acquisition Law;

And whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest that the Commission should construct at Kaimakli, within the District of Nicosia, grain silos and pits for underground storage;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Governor, do hereby declare the construction by the Commission of grain silos and pits for underground storage to be an undertaking of public utility, and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking, and do hereby entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to the Commission.
