THE ELECTRICITY DEVELOPMENT LAWS, 1952 TO 1954.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 27 (3).

Whereas by Notification published under No. 660 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 18th November, 1954, (hereinafter referred to as "the notice"), the Electricity Authority of Cyprus (hereinafter referred to as "the Authority"), gave notice that the immovable property described in the notice (hereinafter referred to as "the immovable property"), is required by the Authority for the purpose of its functions, that is to say, for the purpose of erecting a substation ;

And whereas the Authority has, at the expiration of the period set out in the notice, forwarded to the Governor a plan of the immovable property, together with the particulars required to be furnished under section 27 (2) of the Electricity Development Laws, 1952 to 1954, no objections or statements having been made against the proposed acquisition ;

And whereas I, the Governor, have approved the plan submitted and have considered it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances of the case, that the immovable property in question be acquired :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 27 (3) of the Electricity Development Laws, 1952 to 1954, I, the Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition under the provisions of the said Laws, of the immovable property.

THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS LAW.

CAP. 152.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

Cap. 152.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 of the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors Law, His Excellency the Governor orders as follows :—

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1. This Order may be cited as the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors (Retailers Closing Hours) (Amendment) Order, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors (Retailers Closing Hours) Order (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Orders").

2. Paragraph 6 of the principal Orders is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "midnight" from sub-paragraph (b) and (c) thereof and the substitution of "3 a.m." therefor and the substitution of the following proviso at the end of sub-paragraph (c) thereof :

"Provided that the Commissioner may, having regard to the locality of the licensed premises or the amount or general nature of business carried on therein, refuse the grant of a permit under sub-paragraph (b) and (c) hereof on the ground that it would be unreasonable or against the public interest or prejudicial to good order so to do".
