ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 22 (a) (i).

Authority to the Improvement Board of Moniatitis to contract a loan.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 22 (a) (i) of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, I, the Colonial Secretary, do hereby order as follows :—

1. The Improvement Board of Moniatitis (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lenders") a sum not exceeding seven hundred pounds (£700) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say :—

- (a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Board to the Lenders in six equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest);
- (b) the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Board for the purpose of the repair of streets and construction of a slaughter-house.

2. For the purpose of securing the repayment of the sum under the loan, the Board shall, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, mortgage to the Lenders all the rates, fees, rents, tolls or charges now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Board.

No. 109. THE BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREAS LAW.
CAP. 222 AND LAW 23 OF 1951.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 2.

Whereas in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Bombardment Range Areas Law, His Excellency the Governor, by Notifications Nos. 104 and 105 dated the 29th February, 1952, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 5th March, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Notifications") had declared certain areas therein enumerated to be Bombardment Range Areas for the purposes of the aforesaid Law for a period of twelve months from the date of the principal Notifications, which period was later extended till the 27th day of February, 1955, by Notification No. 21 dated the 13th January, 1953, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 21st January, 1953, and by Notification No. 16 dated the 5th day of January, 1954, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 14th January, 1954;

And whereas it is desirable that the period of the principal Notifications should be further extended till the 31st day of May, 1956:

Now, therefore, this is to declare that the principal Notifications shall be in full force and effect for a further period commencing on the 28th day of February, 1955, and ending on the 31st day of May, 1956.
