

6. The Fourth Appendix to the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion of the words and brackets “ (Day School/Evening School) ” immediately after the words “ Secondary School ” in the third line of the body of the certificate contained in the said Appendix.

7.—(1) The Tenth Appendix to the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by the substitution for paragraph 1 thereof of the following paragraph :—

“ 1. Salaries and allowances of teachers in Public-aided Secondary Schools shall be as follows :—

(b) by the substitution for paragraph 2 thereof of the following paragraph :—

“ 2. A cost of living allowance may, with the approval of the Governor, be paid to teachers in Public-aided Secondary Schools at such rates as may, from time to time, be determined by the Governor.” ;

(c) by the deletion of paragraph 5 thereof.

(2) This regulation shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1953.

8.—(1) The Secondary Education (Public-aided Secondary Schools) Regulations, 1952 (set out in the Second Schedule to the Secondary Education (Amendment) Law, 1952, and as amended by the Secondary Education (Public-aided Secondary Schools) (Amendment) Regulations, 1952, and by section 6 of the Secondary Education (Amendment) Law, 1954), are hereby revoked.

(2) This regulation shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1954.
