THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT) LAWS, 1950 AND 1953.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE IMPROVEMENT BOARD OF LYSO.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 24 of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, the Improvement Board of Lyso hereby make the following bye-laws:—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Lyso Bye-laws, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Lyso Bye-laws, 1951 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Bye-laws”) and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Lyso Bye-laws, 1951 and 1955.

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2. Bye-law 179 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “three piastres” in line three immediately after the words “shall be” and by the substitution therefor of the words “six piastres”.

The above bye-laws have been approved by the Colonial Secretary.
