

4. Paragraph (1) of bye-law 252B (as set out in Notification No. 231, *Gazette* No. 3124, Supplement No. 3 of 3rd July, 1944, and Notification No. 95, *Gazette* No. 3487, Supplement No. 3 of 16th March, 1950) is hereby deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor :—

“ 252.—(1) Every licensee of an hotel classified as hotel *de luxe* and first class shall pay to the Town Clerk and Treasurer a fee of 6 piastres per night and every licensee of an hotel classified as second class a fee of 5 piastres per night and every licensee of an hotel classified as third class a fee of 3½ piastres per night and every licensee of an hotel of any other class, a fee of 2 piastres per night in respect of every person of over ten years of age, staying or residing at such hotel.”

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor. (M.P. 1961/49/2.)

**No. 256. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.**  
CAP. 142.

**RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF PYRGA IN THE DISTRICT OF LARNACA UNDER SECTION 9.**

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Pyrga hereby make the following rules :—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Pyrga) Rules, 1955, and shall come into operation on their publication in the *Gazette*.

2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) and (3) of this rule, the Village Health (Nikos) Rules, 1952, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th November, 1952, shall—

(a) be deemed to be rules made by the Village Health Commission of Pyrga and to be incorporated herein; and

(b) apply to the village of Pyrga: Provided that for the word “Nikos” and for the word “Nicosia” whenever they occur in the model Rules, the word “Pyrga” and the word “Larnaca” shall be substituted respectively.

(2) The rules set out in Part I of the Schedule hereto shall be substituted for the corresponding rules of the Village Health (Nikos) Rules, 1952.

(3) Those rules of the Village Health (Nikos) Rules, 1952, mentioned in Part II of the Schedule hereto, shall not apply to the village of Pyrga.

*Rule 19.* The following fees shall be paid by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in the slaughter-house, that is to say :—

(a) For every bullock, camel, cow or ox .. .. .	s. p.
(b) For every goat, kid, lamb or sheep .. .. .	1 0
(c) For every swine .. .. .	4½

*Rule 31.* The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any perishable goods in the market of perishable goods, that is to say :—

(a) For perishable goods valued up to 5/- .. .. .	s. p.
(b) For perishable goods valued between 5/- to 10/- .. .. .	2
(c) For perishable goods valued 10/- and over .. .. .	4

*Rule 45.* The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say :—

(a) For every carcass of sheep or goat or part thereof .. .. .	s. p.
(b) For every carcass of a young lamb or kid or part thereof .. .. .	3
(c) For every carcass of ox, camel, cow or bullock or part thereof .. .. .	3
