No. 296.            THE BOATS REGULATION LAW.  
CAP. 268.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in him under section 8 of the Boats Regulations Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make Cap. 268. the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Boats (Amendment) Regulations, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Boats Regulations (hereinafter S.L. I. 600. referred to as “ the principal Regulations ”).

2. Regulations 18 and 19 of the principal Regulations are hereby revoked and the following regulations substituted therefor :—

“ 18. Every owner and every boatman in charge of a licensed boat shall at all times specified in the First Appendix hereto, convey any passengers and any baggage belonging to such passengers from any vessel lying in the anchorage in any port in the Colony to the landing stage in such port, or vice versa, at rates not exceeding those set forth in the said Appendix. 19.—(1) No person in charge of a licensed boat shall demand or receive, or employ any other person to demand or receive, any sum on account of fares other than those prescribed in Parts I or II, as the case may be, of the First Appendix hereto.

(2) Charges becoming payable under Part II of the First Appendix hereto in respect of passengers transported, as in regulation 18 provided, shall be included in the cost of any ocean passage ticket in which Larnaca or Limassol, as the case may be, are shown as the port of disembarkation or of embarkation, and shall be payable by the agent of the vessel at the
