THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to the Notification No. 302 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th May, 1955, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required by the Governor for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein.

All those areas of privately owned land, situated in the town of Limassol comprising 1 evlek and 700 sq. feet or thereabouts, including plots Nos. 66 and 67/8 of the Government Survey Plan LIV; 58; 5; IV of Limassol town more particularly defined as the areas delineated in red on the Government Survey Plan dated the 16th May, 1955, and signed by the Commissioner, Limassol.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands who objects to the acquisition is required within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice to send me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my office.

THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW.

CAP. 92 AND LAW 16 OF 1954.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 (1) of the Foreshore Protection Law, I hereby give notice that except under a written permit from me and under such conditions as I may think fit to impose thereby—

(1) the removal of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from all that area of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto; and

(2) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto,

are absolutely prohibited.

SCHEDULE.

The foreshore commences at the western village boundary line of Moutayiaka village near plot 75 of the Government Survey Plan LIV/52, locality "Pervolas" and proceeds north-eastwards along the high water mark for a distance of about one mile to the point which is opposite to the junction of the roads Ayios Tykhonas-Jarnaca, locality "Iaccos tou Stokkou" and includes all the lands within a distance of fifty yards of the said high water mark.
