No. 320.**THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT)
LAWS, 1950 AND 1953.****AMENDMENT OF ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 22 (a) (i).**

Whereas the Colonial Secretary authorised the Improvement Board of Kaimakli (Nicosia District) to contract a loan for the sum of £1,600, by order issued under his hand and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 24th February, 1955, under Notification No. 127 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") on the condition that the said sum be utilised for the purchase of a lorry (refuse collector) and two trailers for the removal of meat and pork from the slaughter-houses ;

And whereas the Board has now applied for authority to purchase, by utilising £510 of the said loan, a van instead of the two trailers specified in the Order :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 22 (a) (i) of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, and section 27 (a) of the Interpretation Law (Cap. 1), I, the Colonial Secretary, do hereby amend the Order by the deletion from paragraph 1 (b) thereof of the words " two trailers " and the substitution therefor of the word " van ".
