 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Cyprus Special Constables
 (Amendment) Regulations, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus
 Special Constables Regulations, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the
 principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations
 may together be cited as the Cyprus Special Constables Regulations, 1952
 and 1955.

2. Paragraph (1) of Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby
 amended by the substitution therein for the words "twenty-five" (line 4)
 of the words "twenty-one".
