No. 462. THE CUSTOMS MANAGEMENT LAW, 1954.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2772

MADE UNDER SECTION 133.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 133 of the Customs Management Law, 1954, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Hotel Furniture) (Duty Exemption and Reduction) Order, 1955.

2. This Order shall apply to the articles of hotel furniture and appliances specified in the First Schedule hereto in respect of which the conditions specified in the Second Schedule hereto have been complied with to the satisfaction of the Comptroller (hereinafter referred to as " the specified articles ").

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Customs Laws—

(a) where any specified article has origin in a Commonwealth country, such specified article shall be admitted into the Colony free of any Customs duty ;

(b) where any specified article has origin in a country other than in a Commonwealth country, the duty payable on such specified article shall be at the rate of eight per centum *ad valorem*, except in the case of the articles specified in paragraph (g) of the First Schedule hereto, where the duty payable thereon shall be at the rate of three per centum *ad valorem*.
