ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2775

MADE UNDER SECTION 124 (1).

*Authority to the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Nicosia  
to contract a loan.*

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 124 (1) of the Municipal Corporations Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. The Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Councillors and Townsmen of the Municipal Corporation of Nicosia (hereinafter referred to as "the Municipal Corporation") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lender") the sum of five thousand pounds (£5,000) at a rate of interest not exceeding four and a half per centum ( $4\frac{1}{2}\%$ ) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say :—

(a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Municipal Corporation to the Lender in twenty equal annual instalments (comprising
