THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

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In exercise of the powers vested in me by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force in consequence of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1954), I do by this Order order as follows :—

1. I authorise, subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the use, for air force purposes, of the land specified in the Second Schedule (hereinafter referred to as "the land") during the period of six months from the date of this Order.
2. The persons using the land are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for the purposes of its occupation.
3. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

1. The land shall be occupied and used for air force purposes only.
2. At the expiration of this Order the land shall be restored to the persons entitled thereto free of any erection, structure or construction erected or constructed thereon.
3. Compensation shall be paid to the persons having an interest on the land for its use and occupation under this Order.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

All those areas of land situated within the village of Pano Kividhes in the District of Limassol, at the locality "Trapeza" consisting of 48 donums, 2 evleks, 1,400 square feet or thereabouts and including parts of plots Nos. 20, 47, 50, 52, 53, 56, 57, 58, 59, 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, 136 and 176 and the whole of plots Nos. 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, and 115 of Government Survey Plan LIII.19, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan marked Royal Air Force Camp, Kato Kividhes, signed by the Assistant Director of Hirings, Cyprus, and dated the 13th September, 1955.
