The provisions of the Police Regulations, 1947 to 1955 or any regulations amending or substituted for the same, relating to discipline of the Force, offences committed by police officers and punishments therefor, arrests and procedure at enquiries, shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to any member of the Auxiliary Police Force.

No. 568. THE SOIL CONSERVATION LAW, 1952.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 9.

Pursuant to section 9 of the Soil Conservation Law, 1952, it is hereby notified that, with the approval of the Governor, a Soil Conservation division has been formed in respect of the area lying within the following boundaries, that is to say :—

Area A.—All those areas of land at the locality “Psarolimni” in the village of Platanisso in the District of Famagusta comprising plots Nos. 59/2/1 (part), 50, 51/1, 51/2 (part), 59/2 (part), 60 (part), 61, 59/1/1 (part), 59/1 (part) 59/1/2 (part), 59/4 (part), 52 (part) and 58 (part) of the Government Survey Plan No. III.57.

Area B.—All those areas of land in the village of Platanisso in the District of Famagusta comprising plots Nos. 120 (part), 122, 124/1B (part) and 124/2A (part) of the Government Survey Plan No. VIII.1 and plots Nos. 36 and 37 (part) of the Government Survey Plan No. VIII.2.

The said areas described in Schedules A and B are more particularly defined as the areas delineated in red on the Government Survey Plan signed by the Director of Agriculture and deposited in his office at Nicosia.

And that the Soil Conservation Scheme briefly set out in the Appendix hereto will be in operation within the aforesaid area.

APPENDIX.

Five spillways will be constructed. The river bed will be filled in and levelled into bench terraces and converted into arable land. Irrigation Channels will be provided from each spillway for irrigation purposes whenever this is necessary.

The total cost of the scheme has been estimated at approximately £4,100.
