No. 570. THE CURFEWS LAW, 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

Whereas by an Order made under section 2 of the Curfews Law, 1955, published under Notification No. 562 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 22nd September, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to direct that no person within the area of the village boundaries of Amiandos shall be out of doors between the hours of 10 p.m. on Wednesday, the 21st September, 1955, and 6 a.m. on Friday the 23rd September, 1955, except under the written authority of the Commissioner of Limassol or the Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent of Police of Limassol ;

And whereas it is desirable to prolong the date of the operation of the principal Order for a further period of twenty-four hours as from 6 a.m. on Friday the 23rd September, 1955 ;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Curfews Law, 1955, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to direct that the principal Order shall continue to be in operation from 6 a.m. on Friday the 23rd September, 1955, to 6 a.m. on Saturday the 24th September, 1955.
