No. 617. THE GOVERNMENT LANDS LAW.
CAP. 227.

GRANT MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Government Lands Law and of any other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, do hereby order that the Schedule to the Notification No. 399 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 12th December, 1946 (relating to the grant of certain plots of land in Ayios Ioannis Quarter in the town of Nicosia) be amended by the deletion from the first column (under the title "Name of Grantee") of the name "Costas Haralambides" (item 8) and the substitution therefor of the name "Stylianos Haji Iona" who is hereby constituted as the Grantee of the land appearing against item 8, in lieu of the Grantee now therein appearing, subject to the same conditions as in the said Notification contained and subject to the further condition that upon the new Grantee ceasing under any circumstances to be the owner of the adjoining private property, the grant will be cancelled forthwith.

DELEGATION OF GOVERNOR'S POWERS UNDER SECTION 2A.
