This Order may be cited as the Pensionable Offices (Declaration and Consolidation) (Amendment) Order, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Pensionable Offices (Declaration and Consolidation) Orders, 1953 to 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Pensionable Offices (Declaration and Consolidation) Orders, 1953 to 1955.
