ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th October, 1955, I do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia/Kyrenia District No. 2) Order, 1955.

2. No person within the village boundaries of Kato Moni shall be out of doors between the hours of 5 p.m. on 31st October, 1955, until further order, except under the written authority of myself or the Superintendent of Police, in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

3. The Superintendent of Police in charge of the area is hereby authorized to suspend at his absolute discretion the operation within the village boundaries of Kato Moni (or any part thereof) of this Order, and similarly to terminate such suspension and to declare this Order to be in operation.

4. This Order shall come into force on the 31st October, 1955.

2. No person within the village boundaries of Platanistasa shall be out of doors between the hours of 5 p.m. on Monday the 31st October, 1955, until further order, except under the written authority of myself or the Superintendent of Police, in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

3. The Superintendent of Police in charge of the area is hereby authorised to suspend at his absolute discretion the operation within the village boundaries of Platanistasa (or any part thereof) of this Order, and similarly to terminate such suspension and to declare this Order to be in operation.

4. This Order shall come into force on the 31st October, 1955.
