THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW.

CAP. 165 AND LAWS 10 OF 1950, 44 OF 1954 AND 18 OF 1955.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 14 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 14 (1) of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law, I, the Commissioner of Nicosia, as the appropriate authority in respect of the villages of Orta Keuy, Trakhonas, Omorphita, Mandres, Mia Milea, Eylenja, Engomi, Yerolakkos and Geun-yeli and as Chairman of the Improvement Boards of Beuyuk Kaimakli, Palouriotissa, Strovolos and Ay. Dhometios, the appropriate authority under section 3 (2) (b) of the aforesaid Law, do hereby, with the approval of the Governor, define :—

- (a) the area described in the First Schedule hereto as a zone within which buildings for the special trades and industries specified in the Third Schedule hereto *may not* be erected; and
- (b) the area described in the Second Schedule hereto as a zone within which *only* buildings for and/or connected with the special trades and industries specified in the Third Schedule hereto *may* be erected :

Provided that the appropriate authority may grant a permit for addition and/or alteration to an existing non-conforming building, that is to say a building which exists on the date of the publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, which has been used before such date for a purpose which does not

conform with this Notice, and which has been authorized under the Law, where such addition and/or alteration satisfies the following conditions:—

- (a) the appropriate authority is satisfied that the addition to and/or alteration of such existing non-conforming building will not interfere with the amenities of the adjoining properties and the area as a whole; and
- (b) the total cubical content of all additions to, and/or alterations of, such existing non-conforming building made after the publication of this Notice does not exceed 10% of the cubical content of such building at the date of the publication of this Notice; and
- (c) no part of such additions or alterations is less than 10 feet from the boundaries of the plot on which such existing non-conforming building stands; and
- (d) the total area covered by such existing non-conforming buildings together with all such additions and/or alterations is less than 50% of the area of the plot on which such building stands.

The plot, on which such existing non-conforming buildings stand, for the purposes of conditions (c) and (d) above, is the area of land which on the date of the publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* is registered together with such buildings in the books of the Lands and Surveys Department.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

All that area of land, except the areas set out in the Second Schedule, within the area of the villages of Orta Keuy, Trakhonas, Omorphita, Mandres, Mia Milea, Eylenja, Engomi, Yerolakkos and Geunyeli and of the Improvement Boards of Beuyuk Kaimakli, Palouriotissa, Strovolos and Ayios Dhometios stretching from the Municipal boundary of the Municipal Corporation of Nicosia, shown edged green on the Planning and Housing Department Plans Numbered "N/D/4 (1) to N/D/4 (14), N/D/4 (14A) and N/D/4 (15) to N/D/4 (40)" inclusive, to the following boundary, that is to say:—

The boundary commences at the north-eastern corner of plot No. 250 of Block "D", Engomi village, which corner is on the Nicosia-Airport road and proceeds northwards in a straight line to the most southern point of plot No. 54 of Block "D", Ayios Dhometios village; thence northwards in a straight line to the north-western corner of plot No. 56 of Block "E", Ayios Dhometios village; thence north-eastwards in a straight line to the most southern point of plot No. 210 of Block "G", Geunyeli village; thence north-eastwards in a straight line to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 15 of Block "E", Orta Keuy village; thence north-eastwards in a straight line to the north-western corner of plot No. 127 of Block "C", Mandres village; thence eastwards in a straight line to the most western point of plot No. 896 of Block "D", Mandres village; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 205 of Block "D", Mandres village; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 322 of Block "D", Mandres village; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 436 of Block "E", Mia Milea village; thence south-westwards in a straight line to the north-western corner of plot No. 135 of Block "D", Beuyuk Kaimakli village; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the most eastern point of plot No. 123 of Block "D", Beuyuk Kaimakli village; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the most northern point of plot No. 85 of Block "E", Beuyuk Kaimakli village; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 206 of Block "J", Beuyuk Kaimakli village; thence southwards in a straight line to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 189 of Block "C", Eylenja village; thence south-westwards in a straight line to the north-western corner of plot No. 92 of Block "F", Eylenja village; thence south-westwards
