THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to the Notification No. 722 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 24th November, 1955, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required by the Governor for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

All the privately-owned lands situated within the area edged red on the Government Survey Plan marked “POLICE TRAINING CAMP”, signed by the Acting Director of Public Works and dated the 21st November, 1955, which area is within the limits of Block B, Eylenja village and is bounded approximately by the Melkonian Institute to the north, the Cyprus Broadcasting Station to the east, the road to the Beer Factory to the south and the Nicosia-Limassol main road to the west.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands who objects to the acquisition is required within ten days from the date of the publication of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my office.
