DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY UNDER SECTION 21.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 21 of the Tobacco Law, I, the Governor, do hereby depute the Director of Commerce and Industry to exercise on my behalf all the powers which I am empowered to exercise under the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 48 of the Tobacco Law.

No. 42. THE CUSTOMS MANAGEMENT LAWS, 1954 AND 1955.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2820

MADE UNDER SECTION 42.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 42 of the Customs Management Laws, 1954 and 1955, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Management (Importation of Hemp and Poppy Seed) (Restriction) (Amendment) Order, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Customs Management (Importation of Hemp and Poppy Seed) (Restriction) Order, 1955 (hereinafter called "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may be cited as the Customs Management (Importation of Hemp and Poppy Seed) (Restriction) Orders, 1955 and 1956.

2. In the third line of clause 3 of the principal Order the words "Commerce and Industry" shall be substituted for the word "Agriculture".

3. This Order shall come into operation as from the first day of February, 1956.
