ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 34 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor under paragraph 34 (1) (b) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 807 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 22nd December, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Larnaca, hereby prohibit the use of motor cycles and bicycles within the municipal limits of Larnaca, between the hours of 6.30 p.m. and 4 a.m. as from 6.30 p.m. on Friday the 9th March, 1956, until further notice.
