THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL,  
1939 AND 1952.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1952, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) (Amendment No. 5) Regulations, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 4) 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1956.

2. Regulation 39 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after paragraph (5) thereof, of the following new paragraphs :—

"(6) For the purposes of this Regulation the expression ' premises ' shall include a dwelling-house :

Provided that in the case of a dwelling-house no order shall be made under this Regulation—

- (a) except with the approval of the Governor ;
- (b) unless an enquiry into the facts and circumstances giving rise to such order has been held by the Commissioner of the District.
