THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 8) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 8) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I give notice that in the interests of public order and safety I have taken possession until further notice of the land specified in the Schedule hereto.

2. Her Majesty's Forces are hereby authorized to do in relation to the land anything which the owner or any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of such ownership or interest as may be necessary for security purposes.

3. The exercise of any right relating to the land which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this order shall remain in force.

SCHEDULE.

1. All vegetation in plot 321, Block B, Ayios Nikolaos Quarter, within 10 feet of Apostolos Varnavas Street or of Edison Street together with any fencing materials preventing access to the plot from these streets.

2. All vegetation in plot 163, Block B, Ayios Nikolaos Quarter, within 20 feet of Edison Street or of plots 278 and 356.

3. All vegetation in plots 181 and 188, Block B, Ayios Nikolaos Quarter, within 20 feet of Ayia Eleni Street.

4. The corrugated iron paling preventing access from Victoria Street to plot 365, Block B, Ayios Nikolaos Quarter.

5. All vegetation within 20 yards of Wilcox Street in plots 207 and 421, Block B, Ayios Nikolaos Quarter.

6. The fence preventing access to plots 423 and 425, Block B, Ayios Nikolaos Quarter, from the street bounding the plots on the northern side.
