THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952 AND 43 OF 1955.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to Notification No. 466 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 7th June, 1956, notice is hereby given that the following land is required by the Governor for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

The privately owned land situated at Paleometokho village under plot No. 942/1 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX.8, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Director of Water Development and dated 10th July, 1956.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said land who objects to the acquisition is required within six weeks from the date of the publication of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.
