| <p>4. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after Regulation 35, of the following new Regulation :—
“Signs
and slogans
on roads. 35A.—(1) Where any illegal sign or slogan is written or other-
wise placed on, or in the vicinity of, any road, any police officer or
any member of Her Majesty's Naval, Military, or Air Forces
may give directions requiring any of the inhabitants of any
town, village area or quarter, to remove such sign or slogan and
any person who contravenes any such directions shall be guilty
of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to the penalties
