THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.

CAP. 142.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2862

MADE UNDER SECTION 10.

*Authority to the Village Health Commission of Dhali
(Nicosia District) to contract a loan.*

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 10 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. The Village Health Commission of Dhali (Nicosia District) (hereinafter referred to as "the Village Health Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lender") the sum of two thousand pounds (£2,000) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say :—

(a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Village Health Commission to the Lender in ten equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest);
