THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 11) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 11) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 26th November, 1955, I, Reginald Norman Kershaw Beresford, Commissioner of Nicosia, do hereby give notice that in the interests of public order and safety and for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community, have taken possession with immediate effect of the land specified in the Schedule hereto until further notice.

2. The use of the said land as an Air Landing strip, for A.O.P. and other light aircraft is hereby authorized.

3. The authority using the land in pursuance of this Order is entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for the purposes of their occupation.

4. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise is hereby prohibited during the period this order shall remain in force.

SCHEDULE.

All that area of privately owned land forming part of plot No. 92 of the Government Survey Plan No. XIX.52, situated at Pendayia village, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Commissioner, Nicosia and Kyrenia, dated the 5th September, 1956, and deposited in the office of the Commissioner, Nicosia and Kyrenia, at Lefka.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 34 (i) (b).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor under paragraph 34 (i) (b) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 11) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 807, I, the Commissioner of Larnaca, hereby prohibit the use of motor cycles and bicycles within the Municipal limits of Larnaca between the hours of 7 p.m. and 4 a.m. nightly from 4th September, 1956, until further notice.
