

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1955), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorization for using the land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the 16th September, 1956, and the Order is so extended accordingly.

THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Orders dated the 16th March, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 22nd March, 1956, under Notifications Nos. 215, 216 and 217; and by Orders dated the 12th, 19th and 23rd March, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazettes* of the 15th, 22nd and 29th March, 1956, under Notifications Nos. 178, 218 and 249 (hereinafter referred to as the "Orders") His Excellency the Governor had authorized the use for military purposes of the lands and properties set out in the Second Schedule to the Orders (hereinafter referred to as "the lands") subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months as from the dates thereof :

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the lands should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months as from the expiration of the orders :
