THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1939 AND 1956.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6. ✓

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Registration Areas) (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations, 1956 and shall be read as one with the Emergency Powers (Registration Areas) (No. 2) Regulations, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Paragraph (1) of Regulation 12 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "in writing" in line 4 and the substitution therefor of the words "in manner prescribed in Appendix I hereto."
