THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 12) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 38 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 38 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 12) 1956, I, Vincent Kenneth Johnson, Assistant Commissioner of Kyrenia, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Protected Areas (Kyrenia District) Order (No. 1) 1956.

2. The area specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a protected area for the purposes of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 12) 1956.

SCHEDULE.

Place	Limits
The Kyrenia Castle, and sea and land approaches thereto.	All that area of land and sea known as the Kyrenia Castle and surrounding land and sea approaches, enclosed by a demarcated line commencing from the Venetian Tower at the north-west corner of the said Castle and proceeding along the Harbour wall to a gap in that wall opposite the Roman wall, thence in an easterly direction along the Roman wall and rocks to a point opposite the Country Club Bathing Beach, thence in a south-easterly direction across open water to a headland at the nearest point to the end of the Roman wall, thence following the line of the top of the cliff in a westerly direction to the English Church, thence northwards along Heleni Paleologina Street by the wall of the Town Police Station to the Castle entrance, thence following the barbed wire to the office building of the Antiquities Department, thence eastwards over the viaduct, thence round the Venetian Tower of the Castle to the point of commencement, and more particularly defined as the area delineated in green on the plan signed by the Assistant Commissioner, Kyrenia, dated the 23rd October, 1956, and deposited in the Office of the Commissioner at Kyrenia.
