I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 29 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 14) 1956, do hereby revoke the order made by me prohibiting all telephonic communication by trunk call between any places within the Colony and published as Notification No. 1026 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 31st October, 1956.
