THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CONTROL OF BUILDING OPERATIONS) (No. 2) REGULATIONS, 1956.

NOTIFICATION UNDER REGULATION 7.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Regulation 7 of the Emergency Powers (Control of Building Operations) (No. 2) Regulations, 1956, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to exempt the following buildings from the provisions of the said Regulations :—

Sixty-five flats to be erected by the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta in the Old Town of Famagusta as part of the Famagusta Slum Clearance Housing Scheme, a loan for which was authorized by Order-in-Council No. 2850, published under Notification No. 672 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 19th July, 1956.
