(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.****ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.**

Whereas by Order dated the 27th February, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 1st March, 1956, under Notification No. 153 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") His Excellency the Governor had authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the village of Perivolia (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months ;

And whereas the Order was on the 24th day of August, 1956, extended for a period of six months from the expiration thereof ;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1956), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorization for using the land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the 27th February, 1957, and the Order is so extended accordingly.

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In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force in consequence of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1955), His Excellency the Governor by this Order, orders as follows :—

1. Subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the use, for military purposes, of the land and property specified in the Second Schedule (hereinafter referred to as "the land") during the period of six months from the date of this Order is hereby authorized.

2. The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for such military purposes.

3. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.
