THE ANTIQUITIES LAW, CAP. 43.
AND
THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW, CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952, 43 OF 1955 AND 22 OF 1956.

Whereas excavations have been and are being carried out by the French Archaeological Mission in or upon certain plots of land situated in the village of Engomi, in the District of Famagusta (hereinafter referred to as the plots of land) ;

And whereas Government assisted by a contribution from the said Mission has acquired by private treaty a number of the said plots of land ;

And whereas His Excellency the Governor is satisfied that another of the said plots of land should be compulsorily acquired :
Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 17 (2) of the Antiquities Law, the Governor hereby directs that the plot of land described in the Schedule hereto be acquired on payment of such amount by way of compensation as may be agreed upon between the Commissioner of Famagusta and the proprietors thereof and that in default of agreement within one month from the date hereof the Governor hereby orders proceedings for the acquisition of the land and for the amount of compensation to be determined in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition Law.
